By 1912 however, the General Post Office which was a government department had become the main supplier of trunk telephone services in the UK. After much debate the Post Office Act was passed by Parliament on 1 October 1969. The Act established the Post Office as a public corporation with two distinct departments; Post and Telecommunications and designated Post Office Telecommunications as sole provider of telecommunications services in the UK. In 1981 Post Office Telecommunications became a separate corporation and was rebranded as British Telecom. The Post Office retained overall control of this new corporation until the privatisation of British Telecom and formation of British Telecommunications plc on 1 April 1984.

Archival History

British Telecom inherited the archives of its predecessors; the General Post Office and Post Office Telecommunications. Following a company restructuring in the 1990's a proportion of PO Telecommunications and BT archival material, deemed relevant to Manchester and the region, was transferred to the Museum of Science and Industry. Material was acquired and accessioned by the museum in two lots recorded under accession numbers 1999.2 and 2003.22.

Scope & Content

The material consists of:

- one envelope of booklets relating to specific switchboard and fire alarm equipment within the museum collections (1999.2).
- six boxes of booklets, publicity material, directories, technical manuals and operational files relating to manual and automatic telephone exchanges in the North West of England (2003.22)
- **2 boxes of duplicate material**
