Note re Beyer-Peacock: Beyer-Peacock employed their own staff photographer who took the occasional photograph, but was mainly employed as a dark-room technician. An outside photographer, such as Harry Kenyon and later Trevor Wainwright, was usually employed to take any photographs which were required. These would be developed in the company's own dark room, and the resulting negative left with the company. Any prints were then made by the staff technician.
