6" Slide Rule No. 9202 in card box; graduated in millimetres, made in Germany by A.W. Faber
Empty 4.5" x 5" cloth pop-stud wallet, possibly for carrying fishing flies
Brown paper envelope containing 15 individual paper packets of dyed hair (Supplied by C. Farlow & Co., Ltd., London)
Empty 6" brown suede pocket
Empty 6" x 4" grey wooden box with two fish enamelled on the lid, from S. Sainsbury, Regent Street
Two 3" x 4" empty sectioned card boxes. The "Halford" Patterns, 1904 printed on the lid
One 3" x 4" card box of dry flies from Hardy Brothers (Alnwick)
